1. Number of results indicator - shows the total number of results and indicates how many are displayed on the screen in the current display mode.
2. Display mode icons - click an icon to change the way you view the list:
 - List view (default) shows a list of item titles with thumbnail images and brief descriptions.
 - Grid view shows only item titles and thumbnail images.
 - Brief view shows only item titles and descriptions.
3. Sorting drop-down list - select the most useful way to sort your results list:
 - by best match (most relevant) items first
 - by title in alphabetical order
 - by creator name (author, editor, etc.) in alphabetical order
 - by date the original item was created - choose newest first or oldest first
 - by date the digital version of the item was added to the Portal - choose newest first or oldest first
4. Print icon - click to print the portion of the results list shown on the current screen.
5. RSS icon - click to subscribe to an RSS feed of the latest Portal content that matches your Search query or Explore parameters.
6. Basic Search box - enter additional terms to narrow your Search or Explore results. For more information, see the [Search Overview](#) guide.
7. Categories - select from the list to narrow your Search or Explore results. For more information, see the [Search Overview](#) guide and the [Facets](#) guide.
8. Bookmarks - use your web browser's options to save a bookmark or favorites link to your search results list. You may find it useful to sort the list in your preferred order before bookmarking. For example, you may want to "Sort by: Date Added (Oldest)" so that when you call up your bookmark later, any new items added to the Portal since your original search will fall at the end of the list.

We offer teaching materials that connect

1. Select an item from your search results list by clicking either its title or thumbnail image.
2. A medium-sized image is presented with a brief record.
3. To view the newspaper, click on the image or select "Read this Newspaper" from the red navigation bar.
4. Your search terms are highlighted in yellow on the newspaper image, but the highlighting can be removed by clicking "Remove Highlighting" on the right-hand side of the screen.
5. To dim the screen around the newspaper, click on the "Lower Lights" command just above the newspaper. To turn the "lights" back on, click anywhere in the dimmed area.
6. To choose a page (or sequence), use the drop-down list located above the newspaper.
7. To rotate the newspaper page, use the arrows just above it.
8. To view the next or previous newspaper page, use the right and left arrows located just above the newspaper, or simply click on the right- or left-hand side of the displayed newspaper page.
9. To find your original search terms throughout the text, click on "Page Hits . . ." in the red navigation bar. When the page hits display opens, click on a thumbnail image or page/sequence number to view that page.
10. To search additional terms within the newspaper's full text, add a keyword(s) to the search box on the right-hand side of the screen and click "Search." The new page hits will be displayed.
11. To view thumbnail images of all the newspaper's pages (a quick way to locate photographs, maps, and charts in the newspaper) click "All Pages" on the right-hand side of the screen. When the thumbnails appear, click on the one you want to see. The page will open in the "Read this Newspaper" view.
